Based on the current cash position and the 2010 budget, \$75,000 will be available at the end of 2010 for a gift to the new permanent library. After some discussion, it was agreed that the Friends' should make a commitment to the new library of \$80,000, to be paid within no more than three years. It was further agreed that a Fund Distribution Committee, consisting of Amy Holland, Joyce Botta and Diane Taylor, would determine the timing of funding of the commitment. Diane Taylor motioned to approve the budget, Margaret McDermott seconded, and the 2010 Budget was unanimously approved. A copy of the budget is attached.
- Amy Holland requested that a review of the financial records be conducted after the end
 of the year. It was agreed that Margaret McDermott, Joyce Botta and Diane Taylor
 would complete this annual review with Amy Holland and Nancy Pencsak at a date to be
 determined in January 2010

- Morgan reported that Holiday Story Time will be on Thursday December 17th at 6:00 p.m. in the Library.
- The "Read Me" program is still in force and volunteers are asked to take boxes of books to doctor's offices and waiting rooms in the area.

- Diane Taylor reported that the income from the craft sales held at The Hills amounted to \$437.
