- I attended the American Library Association Annual Conference in Washington, D.C. and participated in Caldecott Selection Committee meetings. It was exciting!!!
- The Barnes and Noble Book Fair was held in June and library patrons spent $\$ 2,675$, so the library will receive a gift card for $\$ 535$ later this summer. The story times were well attended with 37 total participants.
- Storyteller Bernadette Nason visited Briarcliff with 16 attendees and LTCL with 27 attendees on Thursday, June 24.
- Our first Pre-AP discussion group for LTHS students took place on Sunday, July 11.
- Lynda Taylor presented How Much Love is in One Mommy? at storytime the morning of Monday, July 12.


## Upcoming Events

- Summer Reading Program events continue throughout the summer. Later this month, the library will host a cooking class, Critterman, Kim Lehman, an afternoon of games, the teen book club, and another Pre-AP discussion group for high schoolers.
- The Buzzards are hosting a fundraising party on Saturday, July 17 from 5-7 p.m.
- The next district meeting will be on Friday, July 23 at Laura’s Library.
- TLA Annual Assembly is in Austin from July 25-28.
- Sara Hickman and the Family Time Rocks band will play the LTCL Summer Reading Program Finale on Thursday, August 12th at 2 p.m. at TexARTS.
- The library will host a fundraiser at Mimi's Café on Thursday, August 12 from 4-9 p.m. Diners must present a fundraising flyer to their server, and then Mimi's Café will donate $15 \%$ from each sale to the library. We will also have a library table display with brochures, calendars, newsletters, and posters.
- The next Friends Book Sale will take place at Jack Brown Cleaners on Saturday, August 14.
- We will throw a pizza party for summer teen volunteers on Sunday, August 15 at 4 p.m.
- Jennifer Patterson from the Central Texas Library System will visit LTCL on Monday, August 23 at 10 a.m. to do an Image Audit. She will walk around the library and give recommendations on how we can best use the space and improve signage. This is a free service.
- On Tuesday, September 14, Workforce Solutions will present Job Search Basics at 3:30 p.m.
- Diana Houston from the Texas State Library will present an Introduction to Genealogy Resources available at the Texas State Library on Friday, September 10 at 10 a.m.
- The Friends will host a wine and cheese party at the Lakeway Activity Center on Tuesday, September 21 from 5-7 p.m.
- Mystery author Susan Wittig Albert will speak on Saturday, September 25 at TexARTS.


## Notes / Items for Discussion:

- The fiction section is completely running out of shelf space. I have been brainstorming with the staff on finding a solution and we propose creating a 'back shelf' category of fiction books to keep in storage. They will need to be alphabetized and easily accessible to retrieve when they are reserved. We will pull requested titles from storage on a regular basis and Earlene has found a volunteer to be responsible for this weekly task. The cost of an additional 5'x15' storage unit is $\$ 75$ per month. We can ask the Friends to pay for the storage unit. We have some shelves in storage, but we might also require new shelves. The books sent to storage will be ones that circulated fewer than three times in the past year.
- It is time to select a CTLS lay representative and alternate for the 2011 fiscal year. There are no term limits for lay representatives, but we must make our selections by September 1, 2010.
- The IMLS Laura Bush $21^{\text {st }}$ Century Librarian grants were announced and our partner grant
with Dr. Loriene Roy and the UT School of Information was not funded. The grant was to support indigenous students attending library school and we would have managed a student volunteer. Dr. Roy plans to submit a new grant in the fall on the same topic.
- I will apply for Texas Commission on the Arts grants later this month to help pay for fall programming. We hope to book Bernadette Nason for Halloween storytelling and perhaps the Zachary Scott Theatre Project Interact (ZACH's professional theatre for youth). Both performers are on the Texas Commission on the Arts Touring Roster, therefore eligible to have half of the costs paid for by the TCA.
- We have a major problem with crickets in the library. Are we interested in a $\$ 375$ power spray treatment from ABC Pest Service?

- I will begin annual staff evaluations in early August.
- Solveig completed three recommended reading lists for adults that are available near the circulation desk and online. She plans to publish a new list every month or two.
- I have been asked to preside at a conference program at the Texas Library Association conference next April. The conference is in Austin, so I will likely only miss one day at the library.
- LTCL gave our 20 TexShare cards in June 2010. In June 2009, 12 were distributed.
- The LTCL website had 1,621 unique visitors and 2,978 visits in the month of June.
- The library currently has 5,694 active cardholder accounts, up from 4,770 on July 1, 2009.
