- I completed annual staff evaluations in early August.
- LTCL gave our 13 TexShare cards in July 2010. In July 2009, 20 were distributed.
- The LTCL website had 1,701 unique visitors and 3,056 visits in the month of July.
- The library currently has 5,789 active cardholder accounts, up from 4,872 on August 1, 2009.
