- The CTLS Winter Meeting will take place on Friday, January 28th in Belton.
- The Mother/Daughter Book Club will begin on Sunday, January 30th at 2 p.m. We will read Kirkpatrick Hill's *The Year of Miss Agnes* and plan to meet about once a month.
- I will speak at the PEO luncheon on Thursday, February 3rd.
- Lake Travis Reads will feature author Ben Rehder in 2011. The culminating author event will take place at the Bee Cave Public Library on Wednesday, February 9th at 7 p.m.
- I plan to attend the CTLS Summer Reading Program workshop on Friday, February 11th.

Notes / Items for Discussion:

- Art Attack in the Hill Country Galleria will hold the *Have a Heart, Help Buy a Book* fundraiser from January 12-February 12. For every \$10 heart a customer purchases, \$8 will be given back to the library of choice. (Either Bee Cave Public Library or LTCL).
- I have applied for a 2011 Texas Book Festival Collections Enhancement Grant for \$500 to purchase audiobooks.
- Our IKON monthly fee will rise to \$129 from \$125 to increase our copy allotment to 3,000 from 2,000.
- We were awarded an Arts Respond Performance Support grant for \$110 from the Texas Commission on the Arts for Bernadette Nason's February performance.
- We have started making purchases with our 2011 Loan Star funds. DVDs, audiobooks, art books, and more will be purchased.
- Now that I have completed my term on the Caldecott committee, I will be adding hundreds of picture books to the collection in the coming weeks.
- LTCL gave out 9 TexShare cards in December 2010. Last December, 10 were distributed.
- The LTCL website had 1,511 unique visitors and 2,937 visits in the month of December.
- The library currently has 6,151 active cardholder accounts, up from 5,247 in January 2010.
