- We have begun using the new Navigator ILL system. Patrons are able to make their own requests online and items are checked out on their regular library accounts. We plan to continue implementation and notifying staff and patrons in the coming month.
- Overdue letters were mailed to approximately 75 patrons in August. I will follow up with phone calls later this fall.
- I will take vacation days Thursday, October 27th through Tuesday, November 1st.
- LTCL gave out 9 TexShare cards in August 2011. Last August, 13 were distributed.
- The LTCL website had 1,825 unique visitors and 3,568 visits in the month of August.
- The library currently has 6,756 active cardholder accounts, up from 5,890 in September 2010.
