Accomplished in FY 11/12

- Implemented OCLC Navigator statewide online InterLibrary Loan system.
- Continued promoting OverDrive Digital Library and offered introductory classes every month. In total, 123 people attended classes in FY 11/12.
- Began reviewing technology proposals for the new library building.
- Administered bi-annual maintenance on all staff and public computers, including disc clean-up, disc check, and defragmentation.
- Completed monthly backup of staff computers to an external hard drive.
- Added more RAM to the Volunteer Checkout computer.
- Cleaned the internal casings of all computers to ensure that proper airflow and function could occur with the computers.
- Replaced the staff printer (Canon) in the workroom.

Goals in FY 12/13

- Continue to promote the OCLC Navigator statewide online Interlibrary Loan system and ensure that staff, volunteers and patrons understand the system.
- Continue to promote OverDrive Digital Library and offer monthly classes as attendance dictates.
- Continue to review technology proposals for the new library building and select vendor for implementation.
- Replace all library computers (patron, catalog, staff, and circulation) and install network in the new library.
- Upgrade Microsoft Office products on all computers.
- Create an equipment replacement schedule to implement in the new library.
