<u>Notes</u>

- I have accepted a two year appointment as a member of the PLA John Iliff Award Jury. The award honors the life and accomplishments of John Iliff, early adopter and champion of technology in public libraries, and recognizes the contributions of a library worker, librarian, or library that has used technology and innovative thinking as a tool to improve services to public library users.
- Yvette has been appointed to TSLAC's TexShare Card Working Group. Her appointment is for a term beginning immediately and going through August 31, 2017.
- TSLAC will provide a partial reimbursement of \$183 to help defray a portion of the direct costs we have incurred for participating in the ILL program during State Fiscal Year 2014.
- Attached is a TSLAC provided comparison report for the previous two years.
- We plan to be a drop-off location for local LT lov's Green Santa holiday toy drive.
- Currently, faxes cost \$1 per page. As this service is not intended to be a money making venture, we plan to lower the cost to \$1 per fax starting in November.
- The Long Range Planning Committee will distribute the attached community survey over the next few months. We will also hold two open community forums in November to solicit feedback. Please see the attached map representation of our member population.
- Award-winning entries from the fourth annual Teen Read Week Art Contest will be on display in the meeting room in November. This year we had 209 (!) entries.
- Alan and I plan to visit the Westminster Manor in Austin on either October 28th or November 6th to see the acoustical panels in place. The total cost to install the panels is \$10,477.
- S.C. Gwynne will be the featured author for the 2015 Lake Travis Reads program.
- We are now participants in the ALSC/Lego project. I picked up the Lego Junior Maker Space kit at an event at TSLAC earlier this month and we plan to launch our Lego program in January.

- GreenScapes, ABC, and JXC Landscaping have provided bids to repair the amphitheater holes damaged by water runoff.
- I plan to take vacation days on November 24-26.
- LTCL gave out 4 TexShare cards in September 2014. In September 2013, 3 were distributed.
- The LTCL website had 2,481 unique visitors and 4,683 visits in the month of September.
