January 26, 2017

At 3:00 p.m., President Carol Black called to order the two hundred and seventh meeting of the Trustees of the Lake Travis Community Library District. Program attendance is up 17%. The library currently has 10,941 active card holder accounts. The LTCL website unique visitor count was 10,088. These statistics reflect bookmobile statistics as well. Local artist Sofia Besondy will exhibit her abstract art during the month of February. An art reception will be on Saturday, February 4th from 2 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. Morgan, Carol Black, and PK Chatterjee attended the Library District Discussion Group meeting on January 20th
