- Sarah, Karen, the bookmobile, and I attended a meeting at Bee Cave Public Library with LTISD librarians on February 24th.
- The new Moe's Southwest Grill held a fundraiser for the library on February 28th and we will receive \$370!
- \$1,133.70 was forgiven in the Food for Fines campaign in February.
- We hosted a Central Texas Digital Consortium OverDrive meeting on March 10th.
- We participated in LTMS Day of Service on March 10th with 10 student volunteers.

- We have been invited to a librarian networking luncheon on May 8th.
- We will hold a special Dads & Donuts Story Time with a Fairy Tale theme on May 27th. Costumed characters will be present to pose for photo opps.
- The 2017 Summer Reading Program Kickoff Event is scheduled for Saturday, June 3rd. Please see the attached 2017 Summer Reading Program brochure.
- The next Library District Discussion Group will take place on Friday, August 25th at Wells Branch Community Library.

Notes

- Mary Jo Finch and lobbyist Robert Johnson continue to monitor bills filed in the Texas legislature. Some of the main concerns relate to term limits, being able to continue lobbying efforts, permitting TSLAC to set accreditation standards for libraries, annexation issues, and open carry laws.
- The Westlake Rotary Club has offered to install three Little Free Libraries around our library district.
- Thanks to Linden's awesome social media efforts, we now have 1,005 Facebook likes!!
- I submitted a TSLAC grant application to help fund year two of our bookmobile service. The \$72,722 grant would fund the Outreach Librarian salary, a new Outreach Library Assistant position, and fuel for the bookmobile for one year.
- I will complete the TSLAC annual report later this month.
- Thanks to Sarah, we have received \$175 and \$162 from the Texas Commission on the Arts for Joe McDermott and Bernadette Nason programs held the past few months.
- Thanks to Sarah's efforts, we have been able to donate some items from storage to LTISD librarians. We plan to distribute more benches and browsing boxes next month.
- Jordan and I are investigating the Gabbie texting function through Apollo for a cost of \$200 per year.
- We now subscribe to the online version of Value Line and have three licenses for in-library use only.
- The Lake Travis Thrift Store has asked to use our meeting room to hold a jewelry fundraiser.
- Sarah and I plan to investigate furniture and shelving options at TLA to alleviate crowding in the children's library.
- The TLA Annual Conference is in San Antonio in mid-April. Karen will present on a panel about outreach services on April 20th and other staff members will attend according to

interest and availability. I will attend TLA Council meetings on April 19th and 22nd as the representative from TLA District 3.

- I will attend the UT iSchool Advisory Council meeting on April 27th.
- I plan to take vacation days on April 14th, the morning of April 17th, and May 26-30.
- I have registered for the ALA conference in late June.
- LTCL gave out 14 TexShare cards in February 2017. In February 2016, 23 were distributed.
- The LTCL website had 8,323 unique visitors and 23,816 visits in the month of February.
- LTCL currently has 11,188 active cardholder accounts.

Technology Update

- Our Managed Service Agreement with TFE expires at the end of the month. A new agreement for the cost of \$11,500 through September 2017 is attached.
- The BrightSign digital signage player in the front display window broke. We are getting a quote from TFE to install players on all three TVs around the library.
- TFE recommends a purchase of new switches and access points. We have received six eRate bids from \$7,675.96 to \$11,958.95. The TFE bid is \$8,995.20.
- TFE justifies the need for the purchase:
 - LTCL today has two Cisco 2960-48TT-L switches, purchased and implemented in 2013, which have begun their end-of-life cycle. The switches can no longer receive software updates for security fixes and feature enhancements and are no longer under hardware warranty. The switches' ports are also 10/100, meaning their ports can only connect devices such as computers, printers, and wireless access points at 10-megabit or 100-megabit speeds. Almost every device today is outfitted with a 1000 megabit (1 gigabit) network adapter, so the switch ports today are a bottleneck for the network as the library continues to move towards servicing its patrons with digital services. These services rely on the network (the switches) to deliver those services. By upgrading, the library will be covered under hardware warranty, running the latest stable and secure software, and supplying its endpoints with today's and tomorrow's speeds.
 - For wireless, today the library has Cisco 1231G wireless access points. These are an older model that the library had received by donation in 2013 as part of the network implementation for budgetary reasons. While it allowed the library basic wireless access for internal use and for our patrons, that model went end-of-life in 2014, so hardware, software, or technical support cannot be renewed. Like the switches, they are unable to run the latest software which, besides access to software security patches, would allow the wireless network to operate in 'Clean Air' mode which detects sources of interference, adjusts for it, and reports on it. Further, the 1231s only supply a theoretical maximum of 54 megabits to each client, whereas the proposed model supports theoretical maximum of 1 gigabit to each client (same as the wired network). As more applications and services move to supporting wireless, the library's devices and its patrons' devices will demand the wireless network be robust, fast, and secure.
