Notes

- We are holding a gently-used towel drive for Africa's Promise Village / Rotary Club of Lakeway/Lake Travis through June 1st.
- Raj will do her capstone (final master's project) with the bookmobile, planning and implementing programming at Summer Squires camp under Karen's supervision.
- Sarah and I plan to order \$2,000 worth of Playaway Launchpads (playaway.com/launchpad) later this month.
- Unfortunately, we were not awarded a ALA/PBS Great American Read Grant.
- We are close to concluding annual staff evaluations.
- We continue to have problems with our phone system and met with local AMP Telecom on May 23rd.
- We are working with Library Interiors of Texas to purchase shelving DVD dividers and white book support pieces from Bibliomodel. We plan work with them late this summer to address other furniture and shelving needs throughout the library.
- Replacing our damaged book drop would cost around \$3,000.
- Austintatious Blinds and Shutters have installed most of the new blackout shades in the meeting room and plan to complete the project later this month.
- The landscaping crew shattered an exterior glass pane in the teen room on May 17th. AlphaGlass should replace the glass within the next day or two.
- ABC Pest Control will visit the library on May 29th to spray for ant hills, remove rolly pollies, and address pests by the bookmobile.
- Two leaks were found in HVAC lines during the recent inspection and will hopefully be repaired later this month.
- Lone Star Paving has been hired to do parking lot repairs the week of August 20th. We will then close the library on Friday, September 14th to sealcoat and stripe the parking lot.
- We have a quote from TFE for a People Counter that will be significantly less expensive than the bid from SenSource.

- TFE is close to completing the new staff computer installation project.
- Rachel Keeler has completed a CPR certification class and Mariah Froehlich's certification is on file as well.
- In the month of April, 815 users viewed 1,010 issues on PressReader. Some of the most popular titles are the *Austin American Statesman*, *The Washington Post* and *New York Post*.
- LTCL gave out 28 TexShare cards in April 2018. In April 2017, 28 were distributed.
- The LTCL website had 6,113 unique visitors and 22,394 visits in the month of April.
- LTCL currently has 12,238 active cardholder accounts.
