- We celebrated Fire Prevention Week with a visit from Lake Travis Fire and Rescue and a tour of the Pedernales Fire Station earlier this month.

- Raj plans to attend the UT iSchool Capstone Coffee Break on November 1st.
- Raj and Sarah plan to attend the CTLS Performer's Showcase on November 2nd.
- We will have a staff bookmobile/outreach meeting on November 4th before the gala.
- The Volunteer Appreciation Gala will take place on Sunday, November 4th.
- We will again be a drop off location for LTlov's Green Santa holiday toy drive.
- I plan to take vacation days November 19-21, 28, December 13-14, and January 9-11.
- The Friends will hold a Flash Sale on November 30th.
- Our annual Holiday Celebration with Santa and Mrs. Claus will take place on December 11th.
- The Noon Year's Eve celebration is scheduled for December 31st with Songs for Seeds.
- The next Library District Discussion Group is scheduled at Laura's Library on January 11th.
- We plan to send two staff members to a TSLAC Mental Health First Aid training in Austin in January.
- We plan to hold another Food for Fines forgiveness campaign in February.
- Sarah Bird and her new book *Daughter of a Daughter of a Queen* has been selected for 2019 Lake Travis Reads. The author event will take place at LTCL on February 5th at 7pm.

Notes

- Raj and I continue looking into hotspot options for the library. The priority is for unlimited data and strong coverage throughout the district. After consulting with other librarians and vendors, we plan to purchase hotspots from T-Mobile. Senior Government Account Manager Ted Moore quoted \$290.50 per month for 10 devices with unlimited data. The hotspot devices themselves are free, there is no set up fee, and a one-year warranty is included. The T-Mobile price is from the negotiated contract with the State Department of Information Resources (DIR). Please see the attached hotspot agreement that would be given to patrons upon checkout.
- The representative with Charter Communications has received the signed utility easement and it has been recorded at the County Clerk's office. We have received an electronic copy of the fully executed version and it is on file.
- Raj created Batch Geo maps earlier this month to determine where our patrons live. Please see the attached maps.
- The Chamber of Commerce has agreed to highlight the library in a newly created member spotlight feature in a future newsletter. Linden is working on the feature.
- Nextdoor has asked for community reviews and the library has been getting some positive press. A recent review said: Very friendly staff. They deserve a medal for all the special programs and events they provide for our citizens.
- We are working on a capstone proposal with current volunteer Miriam Goff.

- Rachel and Morgan are creating a collection development policy that they hope to present to the board in the next few months.
- We have encountered challenges during construction of the Lakeway Police Facility. Our phone cable was cut, the banner pole was damaged, irrigation lines near the road were severed, and we have had an ant infestation. City Manager Steve Jones ensures us that all problems will be taken care of.
- DVD dividers and book supports from Library Interiors of Texas should arrive next week.
- I have ordered a sign from Stokes to put on our dumpster enclosure to discourage public use.
- We are working with Stokes to replace our damaged donor sign and missing knobs on the children's computer table.
- Replacing our damaged book drop would cost around \$3,000.
- We may ask Austintatious Blinds and Shutters to provide a quote to install blinds in the workroom.
- JXC Landscaping looked at our trees and do not recommend any work at this time. They will also provide a bid for a new product to prevent gravel erosion around the trail surrounding the library.
- Lone Star Paving again had to cancel parking lot work on October 22nd due to rain. We hope to reschedule the work for January 21st when we are already closed for Martin Luther King, Jr. Day. ABC completed repairs to the HVAC in the meeting room on October 22nd and properly insulated the coils in the wall.
- We continue to work with TFE and ipower to migrate our website to a more secure https.
- In the month of September, 1,582 users viewed 2,039 issues on PressReader. Some of the most popular titles are the *Austin American-Statesman*, *The Washington Post* and *The New York Post*. As of late September, the Austin American-Statesman is no longer available through PressReader due to a change in publication ownership.
- LTCL gave out 38 TexShare cards in September 2018. In September 2017, 31 were distributed.
- The LTCL website had 9,476 unique visitors and 24,564 visits in the month of September.
- LTCL currently has 12,533 active cardholder accounts.
