February is "Fine Forgiveness" month with food donations going to the Lake Travis Crisis Ministry. Texas Library Association meeting is April 15-18 in Austin. Staff will be attending. Two library-school students from UT are working on their Capstone projects, volunteering in the library, working with DVD and children's collections. Adult programs are beyond capacity.
