- Rachel and I are meeting with a UT iSchool student on Monday, April 29th for a potential fall capstone project.

- The wedding in the library amphitheater will indeed take place on May 27th.
- The 2019 Summer Reading Program kickoff party will take place on Saturday, June 1st.
- Rachel and I will attend ALA in DC in late June. I plan to take one vacation day during my time in DC and four vacation days in early July.
- The next Library District Discussion Group is scheduled at Wells Branch Community Library on Friday, August 16th.

Outreach News

- As recommended by TML Loss Prevention Specialist, Karen and Khalil have developed the attached Safe Driver Training Program document.
- We now have nine active homebound delivery patrons and continue to advertise the service.
- The bookmobile celebrated National Bookmobile Day on April 10th with a bookmobile toddler story time, a pizza party at Deer Creek, and coloring sheets decorating the inside of the bus. We also received a surprise thank you card from One Chapel Preschool.
- Khalil created a video about the bookmobile in support of the TLA panel *Libraries on the Move: A Panel on Mobile Outreach*, where six libraries with mobile outreach programs discussed how they serve their communities. Morgan heard many positive comments about Karen's presentation on the panel!
- Karen and volunteer Patsy Bellerby attended the Lakeway Church Easter Egg Hunt with approximately 300 participants of all ages visiting the bookmobile and receiving free books.
- Rachel received a thank you card from Lake Travis United Methodist Church for her visits to their preschool with the bookmobile.

- Karen staffed a booth at the Lake Travis Senior Services Aging Well Expo at the Lakeway Activity Center on April 23rd, receiving many great comments about the library from existing patrons and spreading the word about homebound delivery.
- Khalil presented *Travels and Tales: A Travel through Spain* for residents at the Legacy Oaks Assisted Living facility on April 24th. Nine people participated.
- The Lake Travis Chamber of Commerce SpringFest is Saturday, April 27th at the Hill Country Galleria.
- The bookmobile was washed and received its yearly wax by Ultimate ATX on April 18th.
- One passenger side tire was flat and Discount Tire refilled with air. We are keeping an eye on it to see if we need a new tire.

Notes

- A legislative update from Mary Jo Finch is attached.
- A patron has emailed us, a Lakeway City Council member, Legend Communities, and Tuscan Village to request that a stoplight be installed at the Tuscan Village entrance.
- We are working with Library Interiors of Texas to finalize the order for the children's room. We will purchase two iPads to serve as catalog stations and relocate the Kilgo donor sign.
- I completed the 2018 TSLAC Annual Report.
- Sue and I recently completed a Public Information Request from SmartProcure.
- Wells Fargo is discontinuing its payroll service business, so Alan and I are transitioning us to the recommended APD.
- Alan and I are working to update our 457 plan documents with NBS.
- A Ricoh copy machine is scheduled to be delivered on May 8th that will hopefully save us money and be able to better handle our large monthly calendars.
- We have started the annual staff evaluation process.
- Khalil continues to schedule Book-a-Librarian sessions and we could use help spreading the word about this new service.
- Sarah plans to purchase more Launchpads for the library, this time for older children. We are also interested in a new Playaway product. "Every Wonderbook is a print book with a Playaway-inspired pre-loaded audiobook player permanently bound to the inside cover. They are self-contained, shelf-ready, and circulate like a print book." They cost around \$40 each and we plan to purchase 20 to add to the collection.
- The City of Lakeway reinstalled our banner poles and we are once again able to advertise events on Lohmans Crossing! Other repairs on the road have been completed and we will monitor the growth of the new sod.
- The children's room exterior door is leaking oil and we are trying to schedule service with HULL Door Supply.
- The \$2,895 quote from JXC Landscaping to repair eroded gravel on the path surrounding the library is still being considered.
- Mr. Sanchez Cleaning Service cleaned carpets in the adult and children's areas earlier this month.
- We upgraded our outlet boxes at the tables in the adult library with USB ports.
- Clayworks is working on our latest donor tile order.
- We have received a \$10,984.90 quote from TFE for new public computers.
- One staff circulation desk computer has malfunctioned and we are working with DELL to redeem our warranty. We are also purchasing a backup PC from TFE to have ready in case.
- LTCL gave out 36 TexShare cards in March 2019. In March 2018, 50 were distributed.
- The LTCL website had 8,088 unique visitors and 25,637 visits in the month of March.
- LTCL currently has 12,864 active cardholder accounts.
