### **About the Library**

The Lake Travis Community Library was founded in 1985 and shared a space with the Lake Travis High School Library for over 20 years. In May 2004, voters approved the formation of the Lake Travis Community Library District as a means to create public funding for a regional library. The library district includes Hudson Bend, Lakeway, The Hills, Apache Shores, and Briarcliff.

In March 2011, the library received a generous donation of land from Haythem Dawlett in the Tuscan Village development. The new library opened in February 2013. The 11,000 square foot building includes a meeting space for community use, dozens of public computers, a teen room, study tables, a book sale area, a coffee bar, a patio, and ample space for children's programming.

In an effort to better serve our community, the library also provides a bookmobile and homebound delivery service to members who live within the library district. For more information, please visit our website.
