## FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY MEETING MINUTES

September 17, 2020

Vice-President, Joyce Botta called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

Recording Secretary - Mimi King. The minutes from the April 16, 2020 meeting were approved as written.

Treasurer - Amy Holland. Morgan gave the Treasurer's Report for Amy. The report reflects activity for the 5 months since our last meeting April 16, 2020. Income includes only online book sales of \$3,435. There have been no shelf sales this period. Undesignated donations total was \$2,905. Expenses include donation of \$1,000 for the Summer Reading Program and \$12,000 for the Scholarship Awards. Cash balance remaining is \$10,909. Helen moved and Mimi seconded the Treasurer Report be approved. The motion carried. Complete report with narrative is attached.

## **Other Reports**

Scholarships – Danielle Wilson. Eight High School Seniors were awarded Teen Service Scholarships at the end of the last school year. Friends supported the program with a donation of \$12,000.

Library Director, Morgan McMillian reported

- Rachel purchased new library materials with the Friends' Amazon gift cards.
- The Summer Reading Challenge was met. Friends of the Library donated \$1,000 for support of this program. Sarah gave \$500 each to two local Food Banks.
- A Winter Reading Challenge supporting LTLov Green Santa program is in the works. Morgan asked the Friends for their support of this program with a donation of \$1,000. Helen made the motion the Friends donate the money; Nancy seconded and the motion passed.
- Communications Coordinator Linden Joiner has been publishing the library newsletter every week.
- New Editions Newsletters were launched. Patrons sign up to receive individual reading recommendations from library staff as well as the titles of new books recently added to the collection.
- Additional mobile hotspots have been added to the collection.

• Library installed an outdoor access point to provide WiFi in the library's parking lot. Outreach Librarian, Karen Ballinger - Morgan gave report for Karen. The Bookmobile is continuing to offer contactless curbside reserve pick-up service at 15 of the 26 regular scheduled stops. Stops include preschools as well as Senior Living facilities. Library staff is continuing with contactless homebound deliveries. Karen delivered a box of Books for Babies to the Baylor Scott and White Hospital in Lakeway after they requested more packages. Book Sales - Nancy continues working on her online book sales. Year-to-date Online Sales total \$6,451. Thank you, Nancy! Butterfly Garden - Helen reported plants are growing "great" with the addition of the new irrigation. Won't need to do any maintenance work until after winter.
