Outreach News from Karen B.

• Karen B. has been helping the Brookdale Lohmans Crossing book club by ordering Large Print books from the Texas State Libraries and Archives Talking Book Program. The Talking Book Program provides digital audio books and large print books to institutions and individuals.

- Karen S. has designed and ordered stickers to celebrate the bookmobile's fifth birthday! We will hand out these stickers all month long at bookmobile stops and sing Happy Birthday to the bookmobile at our preschool stops.
- Raj, Gabe, and Karen B. are working on arranging preschool visits with outside story times with Emmaus Catholic Parish Early Childhood Education Program, One Chapel Children's Academy, and Bee Loved Preschool.
- Madison and Kennedy Kull, long time library patrons, moved into a house right next to the Deer Creek bookmobile stop! They recognized Ms. Raj and had a great time on the bookmobile!
- Ms. Hermans at the Sweetwater bookmobile stop said, "Library day is the quietest day in the house." She explained her children immediately go home and read all the books they've picked up on reserve at the bookmobile.

Reopening Notes

- We have paused our expansion of hours and hiring a 20-hour per week Circulation Clerk due to the Austin Public Health's Stage 5 status.
- The Friends Bookstore opened on August 2nd and is receiving an enthusiastic response! Volunteers are engaged and eager to staff the store, the public is generous with donations, and shoppers love buying books. We plan to place an order for shelves soon.

Notes

- On June 30, 2021, Governor Abbott lifted the open meeting law suspensions that had been temporarily suspended in March 2020 in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. As a result, all open meeting requirements will resume on September 1, 2021. Under the COVID-19 suspensions, a quorum of remote, videoconferencing attendees was sufficient—meaning all members could be at separate locations and all be counted as present. Once the suspensions are lifted on September 1, a quorum must be physically present at the meeting in order to utilize videoconferencing.

- I submitted the annual Special Purpose District Information Database Transparency Report to the Comptroller.
- We have been notified by TSLAC that our anticipated ILL reimbursement should be \$318.63.
- The Long Range Planning Committee will have their first meeting in September.
- Please see attached quotes for landscaping repairs from ABC and Maven Landscaping.
- We have purchased blinds for the workroom from Austintatious and will repair a damaged blind in the meeting room during their installation.
- We will pay \$1,800 in plumbing repairs for damaged outside faucets after the February 2020 winter storm.
- ABC pest control has sprayed and removed wasp nests outside the building.
- The virtual Library District Discussion Group meeting took place on August 13th.
- I might apply for the St. David's Foundation Libraries for Health grant due on September 7th.
- Final grant reporting for the TSLAC CARES Act grant is due September 7th.
- Steven Pedigo will speak about 2020 census data at the Speakers' Forum zoom event on September 9th. Pedigo is a professor of practice at the Lyndon B. Johnson School of Public Affairs at UT and the director of the LBJ Urban Lab.


- I will attend the virtual CTLS Fall Membership Meeting on September 17th.
- I have been asked to join the CTLS Long Range Planning Committee and our first meeting is on September 24th.
- The Summer Reading Program concluded on July 31st with our goal surpassed and \$500 donations to both Lake Travis Crisis Ministries and Helping Hand Crisis Ministry of Spicewood. We offered high quality programs this summer and our community responded with enthusiastic engagement. Sarah received much appreciation and positive feedback for our efforts this summer.
- Sarah sent notes and Starbucks gift cards to the LTISD librarians to wish them a happy new school year. We received many appreciative comments as a result.
- I have started paperwork for our TMLIEBP renewal. We should expect a 3% increase and changes with their partnership with Blue Cross Blue Shield.
- We have renewed two of our five current TumbleBooks subscriptions.
- Kanopy stats went up in July! We had 2,032 visits, 346 plays, and 12,421 minutes watched (roughly a 75% increase in unique visitor sessions and 38% increase in minutes watched compared to June). 257 total library users have created Kanopy accounts!
- The LTCL website had 6,486 unique visitors and 16,869 visits in the month of July.
- LTCL currently has 13,407 active cardholder accounts.

Patron Comments

- Linden promoted the new Friends Bookstore on Facebook with money earned from an ad credit. The ad lasted 7 days and was viewed by a total of 1,617 people, all living within a 10 mile radius of the library. 168 people interacted with the post in some way, for example clicking the "like" button, commenting, or reading more about the library through the featured *Austin-American Statesman* article. The majority of people who viewed the ad were women over the age of 65. Here are some comment highlights:
