Who can use monthly home delivery?

- Patrons who live within LTCL district boundaries.
- Individuals with diminished mobility due to a medical condition.
- Patrons whose home can be safely accessed by library staff.

- There is no charge for home delivery.
- As library members, patrons also have access to digital resources such as eBooks and audiobooks through Libby, and movies through Kanopy.

How does it work?

- Patrons will have access to thousands of free library materials such as books (including large print), audiobooks on CD, WiFi hotspots, magazines, movies, and more!
- Library staff will select materials based on patrons' preferences and requests.
- Patrons can request specific items for delivery by calling the library or placing a reserve through our online catalog.
- A library staff member or volunteer will deliver materials directly to the patron's home once a month.

To get started

- Interested patrons should contact the library to verify that their home address is within the library district boundaries.
- Patrons can register for home delivery over the phone or by filling out the application found on the library's website.
- Staff will contact patrons to set up a monthly delivery.
