Awards

Middle school and high school entries will be evaluated separately by the Friends of the Library panel of judges. First place winners will receive a cash prize of \$150, second place \$100, and third place \$50. Winners will be notified by Friday, October 28th.

Display of Entries

A selection of entries will be displayed in the library meeting room in November and December.

Deadline

Entries must be received no later than Friday, October 14th. An entry form is required to be submitted with the artwork.

Liability

Work is submitted at owner's risk. Although every precaution will be taken, LTCL is not responsible for artwork while on library premises. LTCL reserves the right to refuse any entry. By entering into this contest, artists give LTCL permission to use a photo of their entry for publicity purposes.

Return of Entries

Artwork may be picked up starting Monday, January 2nd. Entries not picked up by Friday, January 20th may be disposed of unless arrangements are made in advance.
