### **Outreach News from Karen B.**



Home delivery patron Jeanne Jarvis said, "Thank you all so much for your beautiful card and personal Christmas wishes. You all mean so very much to me. - We are planning a special March art exhibit and programs in partnership with the Lakeway Arts District in honor of Women's History Month.

- HdL mailed us holiday chocolate nuts.
- The LTCL website had 3,545 unique visits and 5,782 total visits in November 2022.
- Kanopy stats for November were 1,905 visits, 616 plays and 17,580 minutes watched. We are up to 644 total library users who have created Kanopy accounts.
- LTCL currently has 14,028 active cardholder accounts.
