



# Art Contest

You are invited to create an original piece of 2-D art inspired by your personal reading experiences, whether it be a re-working of a book cover, a depiction of a scene from a favorite book, or a character portrait!

## Eligibility

Students in grades 6-12 are invited to submit their artwork.

## Artwork

Artists may enter one original piece of art in any 2-D medium that does not exceed 3 feet in any dimension.

## Awards

Middle school and high school entries will be evaluated separately by the Friends of the Library panel of judges. First place winners will receive a cash prize of \$150, second place \$100, and third place \$50.

## Display of Entries

A selection of entries will be displayed in the library meeting room in December.

## Return of Entries

Artwork may be picked up starting Friday, January 3rd. Entries not picked up by Friday, January 31st may be disposed of unless arrangements are made in advance.

## Liability

Work is submitted at the owner's risk. Although every precaution will be taken, LTCL is not responsible for artwork while on the library premise. LTCL reserves the right to refuse any entry. By entering into this contest, artists give LTCL permission to use a photo of their entry for publicity purposes.
