A motion was approved to give the library the money requested. The renewal election of the terms of three current board members, will happen this month. Lake Travis Reads will be held this year at Bee Cave Library, October 2. Attached is the calendar for all other October events/programs.

Construction at West will be finished next month with an opening in mid to late November. Morgan showed a one-minute video of West. There are presently 84 different fund donors for a total of \$317,537.00. Two employees have been hired for West: Sunny Reed and Isabel Valdez. Preparations for opening West are underway.
