Outreach News

- The Lake Travis Crisis Ministries is moving to ACTS Church (1304 RR 620 North, Suite 100) on April 25 and will be open for clients on April 30. The bookmobile was invited to their Grand Opening on May 8 at 1pm.
- All seven bookmobile drivers completed the yearly Safe Driver Training review and did great! Karen B. appreciates all their driving of the bookmobile.
- The bookmobile was washed on April 3 by Ultimate ATX. Unfortunately, the event that the wash was for, the City of Lakeway Eggstravaganza, was moved indoors and the bookmobile was not able to attend.
- In total, 300 items were given away for free on the bookmobile in March.

West News

- After numerous stops and starts, a mold assessment consultant is scheduled to visit West on April 23 and provide a plan to SERVPRO for remediation in unit one. Jim Bannerot has provided the results of the samples taken by Eric Althouse and they confirm that the condition of unit one is not good. An asbestos report may be advised.
- The tenant's plans to vacate is delayed by Spectrum installation on his new site. An updated vacancy date is mid to late June.
- Gutterman visited West in early April to review potential drainage issues at the outpost. It is not possible to install gutters on corrugated roof, but they could potentially design a custom solution for the outpost. Thankfully, there have yet to be any drainage issues on the property.
- We are still operating under a temporary permit for the West well. On April 8, Southwestern Travis County Groundwater Conservation District wrote: With the temporary operating permit that was issued, Lake Travis Community Library District may continue to use the well. It could be several more months before the permit application review will be completed. There are several permit applications for other existing wells that were received prior to Lake Travis Community Library District's.
- We have opened up the meeting room for third-party reservations beginning in May. The reservation process and rules follow the ones in Lakeway. We already have patrons who are interested in reserving the room.
- Mah Jongg is being held weekly from 1pm-4pm on Wednesdays and we are seeing fairly consistent numbers at West with around 10 players each week.
- We are working with Stokes to install more obvious signage directing patrons to the meeting room and bookstore at the Outpost.
- Sunny met the manager of Lefty's Pizza near West and they will hang our Summer Reading Program flyer in their window. They will also put 400 SRP flyers in pizza boxes. Sunny will continue to be in communication with Lefty's owner for future sponsorship opportunities.
- We are hosting a librarian lunch meeting for Bee Cave and Westbank librarians at West on May 19.
- We continue to work with TCEQ and Kyle Atkins from Public Water Systems on the recent Comprehensive Compliance Investigation violations.
- We will submit West for inclusion in the 2025 *American Libraries* Library Design Showcase.

More News

- In March 2025, 523 people used public computers at both libraries for a total of 332 hours.

- At the suggestion of a patron, we have revised our Request for Reconsideration form.
- Staff has begun the annual evaluation process.
- Raj and Morgan attended the TLA conference in Dallas in the first week of April. Raj presented on a panel providing information about leadership programs within TLA which was well attended. From Raj, "This year I attended sessions focused on legislative bills that may affect libraries and also learned more on how IMLS changes will affect library programs in the coming months. As always, I appreciate the board's dedication to professional development and providing opportunities to learn from, and network with, other librarians." Morgan met with other district librarians, Public Library Division members, and UT iSchool alums.
- Adult Volunteer Coordinator Mariah Froehlich was a panelist at the Lake Travis Senior Services meeting on April 8. She did great and already recruited a new volunteer for the library!
- Jenna completed her CPR certification at a class at the library on April 10.
- On April 10, Karen Scott attended a cybersecurity webinar hosted by OCLC. The webinar featured speakers from Pierce County Library and Calgary Public Library who talked about their recent experiences with cyber security threats and data recovery.
- Karen Scott attended a webinar presented by TSLAC on April 17 to learn about preliminary skills used to interpret library data.
- Morgan attended a TSLAC webinar on April 21 with State Librarian Gloria Meraz who provided a brief overview of current programs and the current landscape of IMLS/TSLAC funding.
- Morgan and Raj were special guests at the Lakeway Women's Club Luncheon on April 23. Sharon Rogers and Carol Jones made the book art centerpieces that are now on display in Lakeway and will be on display at West later this summer!
- Morgan has been asked to provide a quote and feedback at a People's Town Hall for constituents of Representative Michael McCaul on April 26. Morgan plans to submit this note: While the discontinuation of funding from the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) is concerning, our current operations remain stable and unaffected.
- The Annual Volunteer Appreciation Gala will take place on April 26.
- Sue Gilman's official last day at LTCL is April 30, then on to her next adventure!
- The Friends of the Library Scholarship Committee will award four scholarships at the LTHS Awards Ceremony on May 12.
- Nicholle applied for an H-E-B Summer at the Library grant for \$7,000 to support the Summer Reading Program.
- Raj has applied for a \$2,500 Texas Book Festival grant to support Libby purchases.
- We are interviewing candidates for the Seasonal Library Clerk position.
- Morgan completed the 2024 TSLAC Annual Report!
- Both the book drop and A/V drop have not functioned properly the past few months. We replaced the locking mechanism on the AV drop last year but the post and holes do not line up. After a disastrous April 15 when we could not open the book drop at all to access returned items, we have asked Library Interiors for a quote for new drops. They are both out of warranty and over 12 years old.
- We are working to schedule door repairs in Lakeway with Hull Supply Company.
- We are working with Library Interiors of Texas to replace our outdoor furniture in Lakeway. After 12 years, our outdoor furniture is rough! We are leaning towards Loll products at lolldesigns.com.

- TFE recommends that we purchase two new servers as ours are out of warranty. There was a recent hard drive failure and TFE provided a quote for \$10,036.44.
- We continue to have issues with our BrightSign media player for our digital signage in the library in Lakeway. TFE presented a quote to purchase a new player for \$1,728.
- Karen Scott and TFE are working to migrate us to a new email service provider. The annual expense should be similar to our current service.
- We are working with Texas Native Environmental to repair a broken sprinkler head in Lakeway.
- The Lake Travis Community Library website had 4,684 unique users and 8,236 total visits in March 2025.
- Kanopy stats for March were 3,467 visits, 944 plays, and 32,388 minutes watched.
- LTCL currently has 18,444 active cardholder accounts.
- Laura left a five-star google review for Lakeway on March 28: This is my go-to library, and it's very nice. The employees are all super helpful for finding books, getting library cards and helping you register to vote. We even brought my mom's kindle and they helped her set up the digital library access.
- Susan left West a five-star google review on April 14: Such a cute facility with awesome staff! I highly recommend this library!
- After posting a five-star google review for Ascension Architecture, Brandi replied on April 16: Thank you! It was an honor to work with the dedicated Board and staff at LTCL!
