Outreach News

- Karen B. applied for a \$2,000 bookmobile grant from the Lois Lenski Covey Foundation. "Lois Lenski, children's book author and 1946 Newbery medalist for Strawberry Girl, had a life-long concern that all children have access to good books. Toward that end, the Foundation provides grants to bookmobile programs that serve children from disadvantaged populations."
- Karen B. changed the generator oil at 4,991 generator hours. She also purchased a new library door bar and a replacement outside passenger light from bookmobile manufacturer Farber Specialty Vehicles.
- Karen B. and Jenna attended the Lake Travis Crisis Ministries Grand Opening in their new location on May 8.
- The bookmobile is planning on visiting LTISD Summer Squires, hopefully LTISD Summer School, and various preschool summer camps during June and July.
- The bookmobile is registered for the Lakeway 4th of July parade.
- The bookmobile has been invited to the Pedernales Farmers Market in Spicewood and the LTISD Kinder Club Party on two different Sundays over the summer.
- After a second bookmobile position was added in Fall 2023, Karen B. and Krista led a major expansion of the outreach program. Krista began with three stops and grew to nine, representing a 200% increase. This expansion includes more preschools and an additional community stop, significantly broadening the library district's outreach.
- After recognizing a need, Krista created interactive reading programs at two retirement centers, partnering with memory care activity directors to provide engaging read-aloud sessions and access to library resources, offering meaningful and inclusive experiences for residents.
- Krista's title was updated from Outreach Preschool Coordinator to *Community Outreach Coordinator Early Childhood and Senior Engagement* in recognition of her expanded outreach efforts across the library district.
- In total, 461 items were given away for free on the bookmobile in April.

West News

- The tenant in Unit 1 plans to vacate by May 23, 2025 and then start on the tower removal.
- We worked with MAC (Mold Assessment Company) Central Texas Mold to draw up a protocol to remediate the mold damage in Unit 1. We took the protocol to ServPro who gave us a quote of \$18,000 for the labor of the remediation. The technician also communicated that was no way to execute the protocol while keeping the integrity of any equipment left inside the space due to the level of demolition required and concerns about contaminated air quality. ServPro did not seem to think that cross contamination to the bookstore or meeting room was a concern. The protocol is valid until July 2025 after which it will need to be amended before we bring ServPro out to address the mold.
- Programs at West are going well! The Planning Ahead: Wills, Trusts, and Probate program on April 30 had 11 people in attendance. Firefighter Story Time on May 6 was very popular! Five firefighters came and they ended the program with a tour of the fire station up the road. Mark Cruz played the first music concert at West on May 7 with 18 people in attendance. Lego Club on May 12 had 24 people in attendance.
- The Friends of the Library donated \$2,000 to the West Capital Campaign Fund to name a West book stack for Susan Gilman to honor her many, many contributions to the library on her retirement.

- Lefty's Pizza near West distributed 400 flyers in pizza boxes to help advertise our Summer Reading Program.
- Morgan and Raj have ordered large Bookstore and Meeting Room signs from Stokes to install on the exterior of the outpost building.
- Austin Living Landscapes weeded the yard behind the outpost on May 19.
- The meeting room is open to third party reservations and we have 4 reservations for May!
- The Area Library Luncheon between Bee Cave Public Library, Westbank Libraries and Lake Travis Community Library was held at West on May 19.
- We have submitted documents for West to be included in the 2025 *American Libraries* Library Design Showcase.
- We continue to work with TCEQ and Kyle Atkins from Public Water Systems on the recent Comprehensive Compliance Investigation violations.

More News

- In April 2025, 506 people used public computers at both libraries for a total of 278 hours.
- We have been awarded a \$6,000 TLA HEB: Summer at the Library Grant thanks to Nicholle's application with assistance from Karen Ballinger! We will use the grant funds to add popular children's titles to our collection.
- Summer Library Clerk and recent UT iSchool graduate Mary Jahns started her job at the library on May 21.
- Kate Winkler Dawson has been selected as our 2025 Lake Travis Reads author. She will speak in Lakeway on October 9 and promotion will start later this summer.
- Staff have concluded the annual evaluation process.
- Morgan completed the 2024 TSLAC Annual Report! TSLAC has made available 2018-2023 Five Year Trends Charts here: https://www.tsl.texas.gov/ldn/statistics.
- In response to the loss of federal funding, TSLAC produced a handout explaining the benefits of the Library Services and Technology Act.
- Mariah Froehlich and Jenna Kurz are now notary publics.
- Morgan responded to a Public Information Request from Rudra Enterprise LLC (REETECH) on May 20.
- We will replace our book and A/V drops with the Kingsley K-C70S 4ever Supermax System with carts. Library Interiors has provided the quote and the installation cost includes the removal and disposal of existing drops.
- We are working to schedule door repairs in Lakeway with Hull Supply Company.
- We are working with Library Interiors of Texas to replace our outdoor furniture in Lakeway. After 12 years, our outdoor furniture is rough! We are leaning towards Loll products at lolldesigns.com.
- Texas House Bill 3834 requires local government employees and elected officials to take annual cybersecurity training. The bill also requires the governing body of the local government to verify and report on the annual training completion by employees. All board members need to watch the short TML Cyber Security Awareness Training video and submit test results so we will be compliant.
- The Lake Travis Community Library website had 3,809 unique users and 7,312 total visits in April 2025.
- Kanopy stats for April were 3,463 visits, 916 plays, and 36,604 minutes watched.
- LTCL currently has 18,631 active cardholder accounts.

- Morgan plans to take vacation days August 15-20.
- We received this email from longtime patron Sarah on May 21: I love that my kids love the library so much! A huge part of it to is the staff! Everyone there is so friendly and enthusiastic! The library is so inviting and y'all have a way of getting kids there and reading by providing such fun events and activities for the kids!!
